PDA to Demolish Three Additional Buildings at Tradeport

Total of 11 former Air Force Buildings part of on-going Redevelopment Effort

(Portsmouth) The Pease Development Authority gave the green light today for the demolition of three additional buildings on the grounds of the former Pease Air Force Base.

This decision follows last June's announcement from the PDA that eight old military buildings on the Tradeport would be eliminated in order to open up 37 acres for redevelopment. That project is ahead of schedule and should be completed by mid-October.

The buildings selected for this new round of demolitions are in despair and have not been in use since the Air Force Base closed in 1991. The demolition project's current contractor S&R Corporation out of Lowell, MA, will also tear down the three additional buildings. The company is responsible for the abatement of all hazardous materials, dust control, demolition and disposal of all debris. The cost of this project is \$199,000.
