Remaining Military Housing Coming Down at Pease

Seven homes are the last residences at former Air Force Base

(Portsmouth) The Pease Development Authority (PDA) announced today that the only remaining military housing units located on the former Pease Air Force Base are being torn down. The seven homes were built on Pinecrest Terrace during the late 1950's and early 1960's for officers and their families. Since the PDA took over the property in 1991, the buildings had been used by several small businesses. But today, the structures have simply outlived their usefulness.

Three other houses in the same area were taken down last winter as part of the PDA's continuing efforts at Pease International Tradeport to develop the land to its fullest commercial potential. PDA maintenance personnel are conducting the demolition that should be completed mid-month, weather permitting.
