**Nickless Re-Appointed as PDA Chairman**  
*Rochester businessman excited about Int'l Tradeport future*

(Portsmouth) Rochester businessman Arthur H. Nickless, Jr., has been re-appointed as Chairman of the Pease Development Authority. Governor Lynch and the Executive Council made the confirmation official on June 4. Nickless' new term will run for three years and expire in May of 2011.

Reacting to the vote Nickless said, "It's an honor to be re-confirmed as Chairman of the PDA. The Pease International Tradeport is an amazing success story and I'm looking forward to being part of its continued growth over the next three years," he said. "We have five major construction projects currently underway across our business park totaling over half a million square feet. And on our airside, Alpha Flying just opened its new 84,000 sq.ft. headquarters. We have plenty of projects on the horizon as well so the next several years will be exciting."

Nickless is currently President and co-owner of Norway Plains Associates Inc., a surveying and civil engineering company located in Rochester. He was originally appointed to the PDA Board of Directors in October of 2005.
